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### **ASHP Foundation Recognizes 2016-2017 Advanced Antithrombotic Management Traineeship Participants**

*Three pharmacists complete intensive training to improve care of patients taking anticoagulants*

**BETHESDA, MD** (July 27, 2017) — Three pharmacists recently completed the ASHP Research and Education Foundation’s Advanced Antithrombotic Management Traineeship.

The Antithrombotic Traineeship is a focused five-month postgraduate program. This traineeship was created to prepare pharmacists to establish, maintain, and improve antithrombotic therapy programs that result in optimal patient-level, population, and healthcare organization outcomes. Each trainee was matched with a faculty mentor who supported them throughout the program. After completing the distance learning component, trainees participated in a five-day experiential education experience, which allowed them to work with experienced clinicians and manage evidence-based, patient-specific antithrombotic pharmacotherapy for patients.

“The Antithrombotic Traineeship provides comprehensive didactic and experiential learning with experts in the field,” said Anne Rose, Pharm.D., traineeship faculty member and Anticoagulation Stewardship Program Coordinator at the University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics. “With all that is changing in anticoagulation, this program offers an excellent opportunity to stay current with practice standards and enables trainees to implement change within their home health systems. The Antithrombotic Traineeship provides participants with networking and mentorship opportunities that last well after the program is completed.”
